What's happening with the former Oxley Secondary College site?

Since the Oxley Secondary College closed in 2000, the site has had a number of temporary government uses. No decision has yet been made on the future use of the Oxley Secondary College site. The Queensland Government is seeking the local community's input on how the unused site can be a useful and vibrant space once again for the Oxley community.

Future land uses could include diverse housing for first home buyers, small and large families, key local workers such as teachers and nurses, and senior accommodation that would enable people to stay in their local area, whatever their housing needs, close to friends and family. Other land uses could include parkland, recreation and community facilities. The C&K childcare facility can continue to operate should it wish to do so.

Introducing Economic Development Queensland (EDQ)

EDQ, on behalf of the Queensland Government, is undertaking initial engagement to guide the future use of the former Oxley Secondary College. EDQ is part of the Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning in the Queensland Government. EDQ has a variety of functions including strategic planning. EDQ seeks to facilitate economic development and a more efficient delivery of services and products to the community.

EDQ has delivered a diversity of housing (including climate smart, resilient and adaptable housing), parks and community facilities across Queensland.
