• Development Services

This multidisciplinary team of planning, urban design, built form, engineering and commercial professionals are responsible for the identification and implementation of the state's PDAs and other catalyst sites and precincts. Development Services enables new housing, commercial and mixed-use development across Queensland through planning, development approvals and a significant infrastructure funding programme to ensure the right infrastructure is delivered in the right place, at the right time to accelerate the supply of development ready land

Housing Supply and Delivery

This multidisciplinary team of property professionals has clear direction to secure sites to support EDQ's housing pipeline and then bring those into delivery phase. The Housing Supply and Delivery team is focussed on partnering with both private industry and government to unlock and enable housing supply across Queensland.

Industrial Development

The Industrial Development team works with key industry partners, government agencies and the community to facilitate delivery of industrial development projects which maximises economic, social and environmental outcomes. These projects include large multi-year industrial development projects (ranging in size) which generate ongoing employment opportunities, activate further development or create thriving communities. They facilitate economic prosperity by championing and securing investment for industry-led economic growth, focusing on commercial and industrial development. The team manages projects and a land portfolio across Queensland.
